

# ACCOMMODATION REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDENT RESIDENCES

## INSTRUCTIONS

**1) If, as soon as I arrive, I decide for any reason to refuse my assigned accommodation:**

- I will take full responsibility to find another accommodation of my choice, on my own, without any financial help from the university
- I will pay the first month's rent and the security deposit.

**2) I will live in the assigned accommodation for the duration of my stay (duration mentioned on the document entitled "Demande de logement")**

- If I decide to leave my accommodation before the end of my stay (i.e. before the end of lectures and exam period): the security deposit won't be refunded.

**3) If I want to extend my stay:**

I acknowledge that keeping my accommodation, or getting another one in the student residences, is not guaranteed.

**4) Arrival or departure in February**

If either of these situations apply, I will contact the "Service des Relations Européennes et Internationales" (SREI) as soon as possible.

**5) I will give the Service des Relations Internationales the date when I will leave my accommodation, at least 2 months in advance.**

## NOTICE:

The SREI has a limited number of rooms available, located near the campus. **As a result, the SREI cannot guarantee an accommodation to every student who requests one.**

Room assignments are done at the time of your arrival, according to the availability at that time. You cannot choose either the size, or the student residence to which you will be assigned.

The booking of the rooms will be done on a "first-come-first-served" basis.

You will receive a confirmation of pre-booking by mail in the late June or early July (students coming for the first semester or the year) or in the late December (students coming for the second semester), with an explanatory smoothly note and the process to follow in order to confirm your booking.
